

## Maurice Donald Hobson Sr.

Mr. Maurice Hobson Sr., 95, passed away on Friday, December 22, 2017, at Signature Healthcare at Parkwood. He was born in Seymour Indiana on October 12, 1922, a son of the late James Buck Hobson and Margarite (Osher) Hobson.

He lived in Seymour until entering the service. Maurice served during WWII in the United States Navy and spent six years on the high seas. He graduated from high school in Indianapolis following discharge from the service. In 1953 he moved to Boone County.

On December 7, 1942, he was married to Donna Darlene (Hamilton) Hobson at the St. Joseph Catholic Church in Indianapolis; she survives.

Maurice retired in 1978 from Detroit Diesel Allison Division of General Motors in Indianapolis after 31 years as an Aircraft Sheet Metal Modification Technician in Plant 10.

He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church, the American Legion in Whitestown, Post 410. He was also a member the Experimental Aircraft Association/ Chapter 67 in Indianapolis, Indiana (Wilderness Field), National Experimental Aircraft Association out of Oshkosh, Wisconsin, Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association in Indianapolis, Cessna 170 Association, Aero Club of Indianapolis and the Indiana Sheriffs Association. He loved flying, working on airplanes, fishing, and spending time with family.
