Betty Lee Brown, 101, passed away peacefully on Thursday, July 6, 2023, at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born in Boone County, Indiana, on November 11, 1921, a daughter of the late Randall E. and Grace (Worrell) Brown.

On December 4, 1943, she was united in marriage to Louis Victor Brown in Lebanon. He passed away on November 14, 1994.

She was a 1939 graduate of Lebanon High School and attained her nursing license from Paris School of Nursing in Paris, Illinois in 1942. She worked as an RN in Lebanon for over 34 years.
