



## Bobbie Webb-Duff

December 13, 1922 - June 18, 2016

Mrs. Rosemary “Bobbie” Webb-Duff, 93, of Brownsburg, Indiana, passed away on Saturday, June 18, 2016 at Riverwalk Village in Noblesville. She was born in Indianapolis, on December 13, 1922, the daughter of the late Dr. D. Lee and Fern (Gooch) Andrews.

She was a graduate of Ben Davis High School and attended Butler University. She was one of the first girl cheerleaders at both schools.

She was married to William H. Webb on March 27, 1942 in Clermont, Indiana; he preceded her in death on June 29, 2006. On August 18, 2012, she married Raymond H. Duff at the New Brunswick Church of Christ in Lebanon; he survives.

Bobbie was a substitute teacher in the elementary schools of Wayne Township. She taught music lessons and sang professionally with the Danvers Julian Band. She was the vocalist on a daily radio show on WIBC in the 1940s and a weekly TV show on WTTV Channel 4 in the 1950s.

Most of her life, Bobbie was a member of Clermont Christian Church; however, four years ago she transferred her membership to New Brunswick Church of Christ where her father had preached during the 1920s. She was a 50-year member of Brownsburg Eastern Star and Past District Deputy of The

Grand Chapter of Indiana.

She was a devoted wife and loving mother, grandmother and great grandmother. For the past 30 years, Bobbie enjoyed wintering in Florida.

Funeral Services will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday at the church with Jim Coyle, officiating.
