Mrs. Bonnie Louise Kemna, 85, passed away Friday, July 24, 2020 at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born April 21, 1935 in Jefferson City, Missouri, a daughter of the late William Walker and Alice Carol (Holliday) Ousley.
