Cary Dean Fengya, 69, of Zionsville, Indiana passed away on Monday, December 7, 2015, at St. Vincent Hospice in Indianapolis. He was born on April 9, 1946 in Gary, Indiana, a son of John and Margaret (Demko) Fengya. Cary was a 1965 graduate of Horace Mann High School in Gary, Indiana. Following school, he enlisted in the United States Army where he served his country during the Vietnam War from 1966 – 1968.

He was married to Judith Robbins-Collins on November 27, 2003 in Crown Point, Indiana; she survives.

Cary retired from AT&T where he had worked as a lineman. While living in Crown Point and Merrillville, Cary also dedicated his time as a volunteer fireman for the town of Merrillville. There he held memberships with the Merrillville Chamber of Commerce and Merrillville AM Kiwanis Club. During his retirement, Cary worked for Campland RVs in Burns Harbor and for Grandview Pharmacy in Brownsburg as a delivery driver.

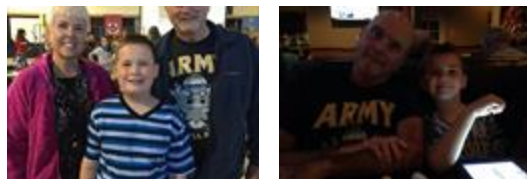
