She attended there until 2011 when she could no longer get out. Cathy is survived by her husband, Tim, of 39 years; a daughter, Stacy Sue McKee; and a son, Steven Ross Nichols and wife, Tara of Noblesville. She was a proud and loving grandmother to her six grandchildren and one great grandson; Steven Henry, Reese McKee, Madison McKee, Caleb Nichols, Abigail Nichols, Isabella Nichols, and Silas Henry.
