Charles Arthur Ranney, 92, of rural Lebanon passed from this life to the next at his home on Monday, July 15, 2024. He entered this world August 16, 1931, at home in rural Lebanon. Charlie, as he was known to loved ones, was the second of ten children born to Ralph C. & Ruby F. (Neese) Ranney. He attended Lebanon and Advance schools and lived his entire life in or around Lebanon, except for his service in the Army stationed in Trieste, Italy during the Korean War.
