Mrs. Charlotte Woody Seiler, 102, of Venice, Florida and formerly of Thorntown, Indiana, passed away on Sunday, May 21, 2017 in Florida. She was born on January 20, 1915, in Thorntown, Indiana, the daughter of the late Clark and Lois (Long) Woody.

On October 10, 1942, she was married to Wallace Urban “Wally” Seiler in Thorntown, Indiana. Mr. Seiler preceded her in death on August 2, 2002. They had spent nearly 60 loving years together before his passing.

A graduate of the University of Michigan, Mrs. Seiler was a Professor of Education at Delta College near Midland, Michigan retiring in 1976.

She was a life member of the American Association of University Women (AAUW) and served on numerous community boards. In her retirement she taught humanities classes, bridge and Sunday school. Charlotte loved living by the water, reading and flower gardening.
