Mrs. Christina Mae Bush, 93, of Lebanon, Indiana, passed away Friday, February 16, 2024, peacefully in her sleep. She was born June 9, 1930, in Frankfort, Indiana, the daughter of the late Carl Leonard and Evelyn Louise (Schimmel) Thrine.

On November 27, 1949, she was united in marriage to James E. Bush. They enjoyed 74 wonderful years together.

Christina was raised in Clinton and Boone Counties and graduated from Lebanon High School in 1949. During her early work years, she was the assistant for the Lebanon High School Superintendent. After she began raising her children and devoted her time to what was most important, her family and home. In addition, throughout the years, she helped Jim with the farming operation they started in 1952, later moving to Harrison Township in 1959. Christina continued to run equipment until their son, Ron, started farming.

She enjoyed gardening along with canning and freezing the produce for the winter. Christina participated in many organizations such, Tri Kappa where she held a membership since high

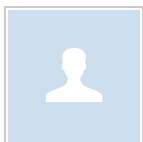
