



## Chuck Stevens

December 18, 1952 - March 7, 2021

Charles E. "Chuck" Stevens, 68, passed away at midnight on Sunday, March 7, 2021 surrounded by family. He was born on December 18, 1952 in Lebanon, Indiana.

Chuck graduated from Thorntown High School, class of '71, where he was a multi-sport athlete, excelling in football and track. He attended Indiana Business College in Indianapolis before enlisting in the US Army. Initially assigned to the National Security Agency in Maryland, he eventually made his way to Southeast Asia as security intelligence through the Army Security Agency from 1972-'75.

He was a part of the Teamsters Union for 38 years before retiring. He was a member of the American Legion in Thorntown and attended the Presbyterian Church in Thorntown.

Chuck was preceded in death by his parents, Lloyd and Marilyn (Gaddis) Stevens of Thorntown and brother, Kevin Stevens of California.

He is survived by three children: Sarah (John Borsdorf), Andrea Stevens and Sean Stevens; two grandchildren, Jacqueline and Kilian; twin brother, Mike (Cindy) Stevens; sisters, Jan Stevens and Lynn (Bob) Patton; along with niece, Ashley (Nick); nephews: Trevor (Lisa), Troy (Mercedes), Tyler and 3

great nieces and nephews.
