Mr. David Earl Nash, 70, of Zionsville, passed away Wednesday, October 7, 2015, at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis. He was born in Gary, Indiana, on June 17, 1945, the son of the late Earl Phillip Nash and Marian Vivian (Carmichael) Nash.
