Dennis Ray Kinslow, 67, passed away Wednesday night, March 22, 2023, at his home in Thorntown, Indiana. He was born December 21, 1955, in Lebanon, Indiana, a son of the late Delmar Lee and Altia Sylvia (Toney) Kinslow.

On August 2, 1974, he was married to Patricia (Leath) Kinslow in Thorntown; she survives.
