Mr. Dennis J. Tudor, 68, passed away Thursday morning, July 8, 2021, at his home in Whitestown, with his family by his side. He was born in Lebanon, Indiana on September 6, 1952; the son of the late Billie J. and Phyllis Lee (Thistlethwaite) Tudor.
