

## Denny Anson Martindale

Denny Anson Martindale, 71, passed away on Monday, March 14, 2016 at his home in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born in Bloomington, Indiana on August 6, 1944, the son of the late Arley A. Hall and Cleon and Florence (Bohall) Martindale.

He was married to Brenda Sue (Eller) Martindale and they later divorced. He was then married to Brenda Kay (Clingler) Martindale on January 14, 1989 and she died October 2, 2005. On August 4, 2007, he was married to Jama Sue (Copeland) Martindale; she survives.

Raised Monroe County, Denny attended Elliottsville High School. Following school, he enlisted in the United States Navy where he served his country honorably.

A longtime resident of the Boone County, Denny worked as a heavy machine operator for Rieth-Riley Construction Company for over 40 years. He retired from the International Union of Operating Engineers Local # 103.

Denny was a faithful member of Park Street Church of Christ in Lebanon where he enjoyed singing. He was a dedicated patriarch of his family. In addition to his family, he enjoyed being on the water, boating and fishing, and karaoke. He always loved life.

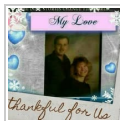

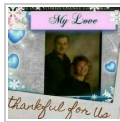
