Mrs. Dixie Lee Hendricks, 80, passed away Saturday, April 24, 2021 at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born January 25, 1941 in Sheridan, Indiana, a daughter of the late Vern Edward and Mary Frances (Lovell) Barnes.

Dixie was a life-long resident of Boone County and graduated from Sheridan High School in 1959. She received her nursing degree in 1962 from Methodist Hospital School of Nursing.
