Dixie Dee Taylor, 74, passed away Monday, November 3, 2025, at her sister's home, in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born October 6, 1951, in Lebanon, the oldest daughter of the late Darnell and Betty Lou (Miller) Walker.

Dixie graduated from Lebanon High School in 1970. Following high school, she attended McConnell Airline School in Minneapolis, MN; then, Broward Community College in FL.

On December 9, 1972, she was united in marriage to Jack Taylor at the First United Church of Christ in Lebanon. He preceded her in death on April 3, 2005.

Dixie and her husband lived in Hollywood, Florida, where she was employed in Human Resources at Qualex, Inc. from 1973 to 1995. Church ministries.
