Mr. Donnell Wayne Parks, 80, of Sheridan, Indiana, passed away on Wednesday, November 30, 2022, in Edinburg, Texas. He was born July 6, 1942, in Lebanon, Indiana, a son of the late Beryl Eugene and Olive Lorene (Lane) Parks.
