



## Dorotha Mae Mills

May 2, 1938 - March 23, 2018

Mrs. Dorotha Mae Mills, 79, passed away Thursday, March 23, 2018 at her home in Whitestown, Indiana. She was born in Clinton, Indiana, on May 2, 1938, a daughter of the late William Kenneth and Lena (Ehl) DeBolt.

Raised in Vermillion County, Indiana, Dorotha graduated from Saint Bernice High School in 1956.

On June 8, 1958, she married Robert K. Mills in Saint Bernice, Indiana. He passed away on July 30, 1985.

Following their marriage, Dorotha and her husband moved to Whitestown, Indiana. In the 1960s, she had worked for the Perry Worth Elementary Schools in the cafeteria and for Dr. Honan in Lebanon during the 1970s. Dorotha had also worked for Appliances Central where she took care of the rent-to-own accounts and then Dave's Appliance; retiring in 2010.

She was a dedicated member of the Whitestown United Methodist Church and an auxiliary member of the American Legion Post 410. She was a devoted wife and mother and enjoyed her memberships with the Boone County Economics Club and several card clubs.
