Mrs. Elsie Mae Owens, 99, passed away on Friday, January 13, 2017, at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born on June 12, 1917, in Rockcastle County, Kentucky to the late John Hale and Sarah (Hale) Hale.

On February 25, 1933, she was married to Casper Martin Owens in Rockcastle County, Kentucky. Mr. Owens passed away on February 9, 1988.

In 1939, Elsie and her husband moved from Kentucky to Sheridan, Indiana and then to Lebanon in 1941 where she had since resided.
