April 6, 1936 - June 25, 2015

Elva Martha (Hale) Fulwider Hively, affectionately known as Elvie, passed away on Thursday, June 25, 2015, at age 79, in Ft. Worth, Texas, surrounded by her family. She was born April 6, 1936, in Kentucky, to the late Delmar and Edith (Owens) Hale.
