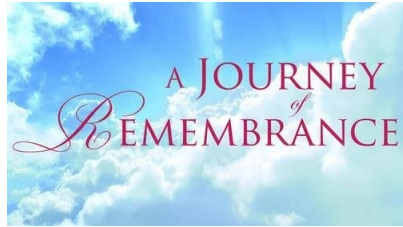

*May God rest her soul and hold her close. She will always be in my heart. My deepest condolences to the family.*

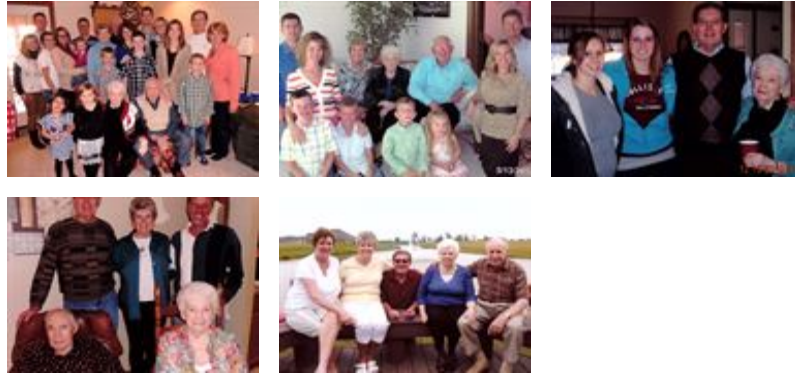
