



Floyd Raymond Lister

December 2, 1924 - March 1, 2017

Mr. Floyd Raymond Lister, 92, of Lebanon, passed away Wednesday afternoon, March 1, 2017, at Signature Healthcare at Parkwood. He was born in Lebanon, Indiana on December 2, 1924, a son of the late Raymond William and Garnett L. (Ford) Lister.

He was first married to Patty (Owens) Lister Iacobelli in Lebanon in October 1947; they divorced. He then was married to Juanita Belle (Medsker) Lister on April 8, 1988 in Lebanon. Juanita preceded him in death on August 24, 2003.

Mr. Lister was a life-resident of Boone County. Floyd entered the United States Marine Corp. in December 1943. He served his country during the Asiatic Pacific Theatre until March 20, 1946.

Upon his return from the service, he spent two years working in Frankfort at U.S. Hames Company. He left there when they closed shop in 1950. He then worked for Commercial Filters Corporation for 36 years, retiring in December 1986. Floyd had resided in rural Thorntown for 28 years and moved to Lebanon in December 1997.

He enjoyed his family and friends. Floyd was active in church in various capacities and enjoyed woodworking, gardening and yardwork.
