Fred Clement Whiteley, 65, of Lebanon, passed away Wednesday, March 23, 2016. He was born in Lebanon, Indiana on November 19, 1950, a son of the late Donald Eugene and Rebecca Adeline “Becky” (Clemens) Whiteley.

Raised in Boone County, Indiana, Fred was a 1969 graduate of Thorntown High School and attended Purdue University.

On June 18, 1977, he was married to Sherry Lynn (Harrison) Whiteley in Lebanon; she survives.

Fred worked as a Field Safety Advisor for FedEx Freight. His memberships included: Eagle Church in Whitestown, Gideons International, and National Truck Driving Championship Committee.

He enjoyed farming, auto racing, and doing ride-a-longs with the Boone County Sheriff’s Department. But most of all, Fred’s greatest joy was his children and grandchildren.
