Mr. Dalton Eugene “Gene” Neese, 85, of Lebanon, passed away Friday morning, June 5, 2015, at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis. He was born in Boone County, south of Zionsville, Indiana on November 30, 1929, a son of the late John Harrison Neese, Sr. and Blanche Marie (Pipes) Neese.

He attended schools in Zionsville, Union Township and Whitestown. Following school, Gene enlisted in the U.S. Army and served as a corporal from 1948 to 1951.

On July 16, 1950, he was married to Sally (Valdez) Neese in New Mexico; she survives.

For a period of time, Gene lived in El Paso, Texas and then moved back to Boone County, Indiana in 1953. 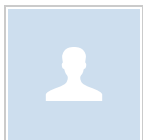
