Mr. George R. Bengé, 85, longtime resident of Jamestown, Indiana, passed away on Thursday, February 3, 2022, at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon. He was born September 17, 1936, in Boone County, Indiana, a son of the late Albert and Ruth Martha (Barnard) Bengé.
