April 18, 1935 - January 30, 2017

Mr. George E. Campbell, 81, of Thorntown, Indiana, passed away Monday morning, January 30, 2017, at St. Vincent Hospice in Indianapolis. He was born in Crown Point, Indiana, on April 18, 1935, a son of the late Charles William Campbell and Susan Catherine (Hessler) Campbell.

Following school, he joined the United States Marines and served his country during the Korean and Vietnam War. George was a POW from 1953-1957.

On January 14, 1984, he was married to Julia Lynne (Parker) Campbell. She survives.

George had owned and operated Campbell's Mowing for several years. Prior to that he had worked in the maintenance departments at the Koala Center for 20 years and the Lebanon McDonald's for ten years.

He was a devoted husband and father, and was proud to be Loretta's dad. George enjoyed spending time with his family. He was a member of the Lighthouse Baptist Church in Lebanon for over ten years.
