June 9, 1941 - August 13, 2024

Mr. George S. Sigler, 83, passed away Tuesday, August 13, 2024, at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon. He was born in Frankfort, on June 9, 1941, a son of the late Al Sigler and Loraine (Hobson) Sigler.

George was a 1959 graduate from Thorntown High School.

On January 13, 1967, he was married to Martha M. (Wethington) Sigler in Colfax; Mrs. Sigler survives. They shared 57 wonderful years together.

George dedicated his life to his family and his community. He was the proud owner of Sigler's Restaurant, a local business he operated alongside his loving wife, from 1959-2019. George and his son John worked as vendors at both the NASCAR and IndyCar events for 12 years.

George was a member of Masonic Lodge #609 in Mechanicsburg, Scottish Rite in Indianapolis, Murat Shriners in Indianapolis, and Frankfort Eagles Lodge #976. As a young child he would ring the bell at the Mechanicsburg Christian Church. He enjoyed golfing, fishing, riding snowmobiles and boating.

Survivors include his wife, Martha Sigler of Thorntown; son, John M. Sigler of Crawfordsville; sisters-in-law, Ann Albaugh of New Market, Indiana and Kathy (John) Cross of Lebanon; several nieces and nephews; and several great

nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, George was preceded in death by his daughter-in-law, Jo Sigler; two half-brothers, Jerry (Delores) Anderson and Ned (Sally) Burroughs; one half-sister; sister-in-law, Connie Lamar; brother-in-law, Larry Albaugh; and several nieces and nephews.

Visitation will be held from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. on Monday, August 19, 2024, at Myers Mortuary, 1502 North Lebanon Street in Lebanon, Indiana. 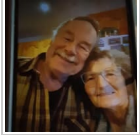
