



## Hildreth R. Perdue

August 9, 1922 - October 20, 2022

Mr. Hildreth Ray Perdue, age 100, died peacefully on Thursday October 20, 2022, at his home in Lebanon, Indiana. The son of the late Ezra M. Perdue and Gertha Mae (Cliburn) Perdue, he was born on August 9, 1922, in Lafayette, Tennessee.
