August 14, 1931 - January 29, 2016

Irvin Martin, 84 of Lebanon passed away on January 29, 2016 at Signature Healthcare at Parkwood where he had been a resident for the past 15 months. Irvin was born 8/14/31 in Lebanon to Roy and Lena (Partner) Martin, the sixth of seven children.

Irvin was drafted into the Army during the Korean Conflict and served two years. He was nominated to attend Officer Training School, but instead left the Army and went to college. Irvin attended Franklin College and graduated from Butler University and the Jordan College of Music. He worked as a band director and teacher for several years.

Irvin met Diane Beaman and they were married Nov 25, 1962. Diane and Irvin were members of the First Baptist Church, Lebanon and were very involved until their illnesses interfered. Irvin was a member of First Baptist Church for 74 years. Irvin worked for Stout's Shoes in downtown Indianapolis for 28 years in addition to teaching music lessons. He participated in many community choirs and bands and continued to teach music and to influence hundreds of students through private instrumental instruction.

In addition to Diane, Irvin is survived by his three children, Gloria Jensen (Scott), Brian Martin and Angela Minglin (Bill), along with six grandchildren, Brandon Minglin, Eric Roesch, Kate Roesch, Kristen Minglin, Danielle Martin, and Trevor Martin and two step-grandchildren and several special nieces and nephews. Three sisters and three brothers preceded him in death.

Visitation will be at Myers Mortuary in Lebanon from 4pm – 8pm on Monday,

February 1, 2016. Funeral service will be conducted by Rev. David Wright and will occur at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 2, 2016 with burial at Oak Hill Cemetery.
