Jim was reared and educated in Clinton County and he graduated in 1941 from Frankfort High School. He entered the United States Army Air Force in 1942 and served as a staff sergeant during World War II. As a fighter plane gunner, Jim served on 35 missions during his time in the service and received numerous military medals and honors. After his discharge in November of 1945, he moved to Lebanon where he had since resided. On January 25, 1945, he was married to Zona Mae (Harshman) Brandon in Denver, Colorado on the Lowery Field Air Force Base. Mrs. Brandon passed away August 29, 1999. Jim had a career with the Indiana Gas Company in Lebanon. He served as a foreman and retired after 43 years of service in 1988. Jim was a charter member of the East Side Christian Church in Frankfort. In addition, he was a member of the V.F.W. in Lebanon where he was a past commander and a former 6th district trustee. He was also active in the American Legion in Lebanon and the Gas Company Retirees. He was a proud husband, father, grandfather, and family man.
