Jane Ellen Sharpe, 80, passed away peacefully on Saturday, August 26, 2023, in Whitestown, Indiana. She was born March 31, 1943 in Indianapolis, a daughter of the late Earl and Dorothy (Rose) Sloan.

Jane graduated from Pike High School in 1961. She and her husband owned and operated American Water Treatment for over 25 years. After their divorce, she went on to work for a detective agency and later sold wedding dresses until her retirement.
