Wilda Jean Unger, 94, passed away at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon on Saturday, July 11, 2015. She was born in Tipton, Indiana, on July 15, 1920, a daughter of the late Lester Guy and Martha (Hinkle) Orr.

Raised in Kempton, Indiana, Jean was a 1938 graduate of Kempton High School and a 1939 graduate of Beauty School.

On April 12, 1947, she was married to Harold W. Unger in Tipton, Indiana. Mr. Unger preceded her in death on October 19, 1993.

She was a longtime resident of Lebanon where she owned and operated a beauty shop. Jean also managed the Lebanon Dairy Queen for 33 years.

She was a member of the Christian Church in Kempton and the Central Christian Church in Lebanon where she was very active. While in Lebanon, Jean was also a member of the Eastern Star and Epsilon Sigma Alpha Sorority. She enjoyed taking walks, traveling, watching sports, reading and playing cards.
