Jeffrey Eugene Wade, 62, passed away peacefully at his sister's home in Lebanon, Indiana on Saturday, April 4, 2020. He was born April 17, 1957 in Lebanon, a son of the late Edwin Eugene Wade and Phyllis Deloras Wade. He was raised by his mother.

He graduated from Lebanon High School in 1975. Jeff had devoted 35+ years in various positions and most recently as the HVAC, Energy and Aquatics technician for the Zionsville School Corporation.
