Mrs. Johanna Adriana Mohringer, 87, passed away Wednesday evening, April 11, 2018 at The Waters of Lebanon. She was born in Maassluis, The Netherlands on April 26, 1930, a daughter of the late Wilhelmus Gerardus Van Dongen and Johanna Adriana Van Dis.

On May 18, 1955, Johanna was married to Wap-Shing Rev. Johannes (John Sr.) Mohringer. Together they raised seven children. He preceded her in death on February 15, 2017.

She was raised and educated in The Netherlands. Johanna and her husband moved to Lebanon, Indiana in 1959. She worked as a registered nurse at Witham Memorial Hospital, The Koala Center, and many other area nursing homes. In addition to her nursing career, she wrote articles for The Lebanon Reporter and authored a book, "Life At The Creek Bank".
