



Joseph C Garst

May 14, 1952 - May 16, 2018

Joseph C. Garst (66) of Thorntown was pronounced dead on May 16, 2018 due to injuries sustained when a truck hit his tractor on May 15. Joe was born May 14, 1952 in Lebanon, the only son of Katherine (97, who survives) and Edward (deceased) Garst.

He grew up near Whitestown and attended St. Joseph's Catholic School in Lebanon. Joe graduated from Lebanon High School in 1970, attended IUPUI and Purdue University. Joe received a BS in Ag Engineering from Purdue in 1974 and began farming on his own.

In January 1987, Joe married Wanda Shepherd Garst. Together they raised five children on their Thorntown area farm. Joe is survived by Wanda and children, Jody, Sarah, Jeremy, Kevin and Ellie Garst as well as many cousins, nieces, nephews and in-laws.

Joe enjoyed his family and farming. He was a very caring person who gave gifts of organs so that others could live on. Joe was a lifelong member of St Joseph's Catholic Church, member of the Knights of Columbus and Boone County Antique Tractor Club.

The Rosary will begin at 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 24, 2018 with visitation to follow until 8:00 pm. at Myers Mortuary, 1502 North Lebanon Street, in Lebanon, Indiana. Funeral Mass will be Friday, May 25, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. at

St Joseph's Catholic Church, 319 East South Street, Lebanon with burial to follow at St Joseph's Cemetery in Lebanon.
