Mrs. Judith Lynn Klemme, 74, of Lebanon, Indiana, passed away early Friday morning, July 3, 2020 at her home in Lebanon. She was born April 26, 1946 in Lebanon, the daughter of the late Franklin Paul and Ruby Lynn (Cox) Oliphant.

A lifelong resident of Lebanon, Judy was a 1964 graduate of Lebanon High School.

and had fun entertaining at local nursing homes as part of the Top of the Hill Band.

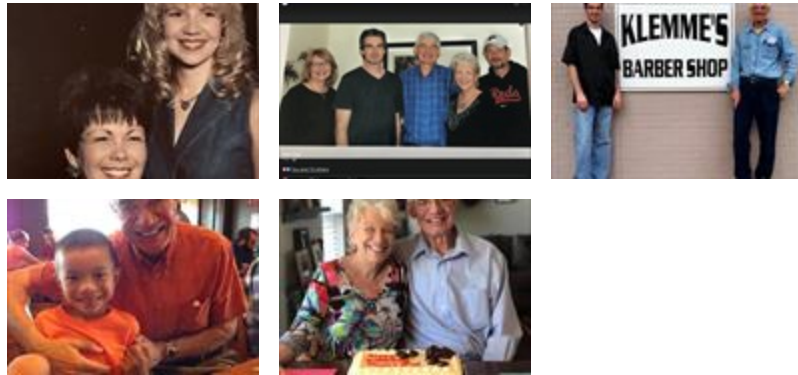
