Judy Kay Walburn, 84, died on Wednesday, March 12, 2025, at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born on July 18, 1940, in Indianapolis; a daughter of the late Gene and Frances E. (Powell) Moss.

On November 19, 1988, she married Nicholas Gail Walburn in Ft. Myers Florida. He preceded her in death on May 12, 2022.

Judy was a 1959 Lebanon High School graduate. She was a secretary at Witham Memorial Hospital, Ft. Myers Community Hospital, Southwest Regional Medical Center, and Eye Centers of Florida, retiring in 1998.

Judy attended First Presbyterian Church. She was a member of Tri Kappa, and the president of the Boone County Historical Society. She enjoyed genealogy, collecting Christmas ornaments, volunteering at the library as well as Witham Hospital. She also enjoyed spending time with her family.
