Katherine Mary Garst, 97, of rural Thorntown, passed away on Monday, November 5, 2018. She was born at the east edge of Marion County, in Lawrence, Indiana, on January 30, 1921, a daughter of the late Andrew and Louise (Strasburger) Klotz.

Educated in Lawrence Township, she was a 1938 graduate of Oaklandon High School. Prior to her marriage, she worked at the Indianapolis Star in the Business Office.
