Kenneth "K.D." Lee Doyle, 71, passed away at his home in Indianapolis on Monday, November 27, 2017. He was born in Lebanon, Indiana, on September 19, 1946, a son of the late Ernest Richard and Iva Esther (Wethington) Doyle.

Kenny attended Saint Joseph School in Lebanon and graduated in 1964 from Lebanon High School. He joined the United States Army after graduation and served in Vietnam in the 11th Armored Cavalry. During his time in the service Kenny earned several medals of distinction, including both the Silver Star and Bronze Star. He was married to Sandra K. (Whiteley) Doyle for 30 years, they divorced and she survives.

At an early age Kenny was a paper boy for the Lebanon Reporter in his neighborhood. Kenny was employed at General Motors as a Millwright in the Truck and Bus division for over 30 years. He enjoyed fishing, motorcycling, bowling and vacationing at Dogtooth Lake, Canada.
