Kenneth Wayne “Kenny” Newman, 80, passed away at his home in Lebanon, Indiana on Thursday, October 1, 2020. He was born in Boone County on November 5, 1939; a son of the late Louis and Lois (Hand) Newman.

He was a 1957 graduate of Lebanon High School. Following high school Kenny honorably served in the Indiana National Guard and the U.S. Army from 1957 to 1965.
