He served in the United States Army at Fort Riley, Kansas from 1948 to 1949. After his discharge, he was called back to active duty in 1950 and served overseas in Korea as a corporal and received the Korean Service Medal with one service star. He was first married to Janice Kay (Miner) Mansholt and they divorced in 1961. On September 4, 1964, in Lebanon, Indiana, he was married to Helen Ruth (Bowen) Mansholt, she survives. Kenneth worked as the Head Manager of the meat department for IGA for ten years. He also worked as a representative for the Jewel Tea General Store for 23 years until his retirement in 1991. After retirement, he worked part-time for Lebanon Berg Vault Company for 12 years.
