Age: 79 City of Residence: Lebanon, Indiana Date of Death: Thursday morning, February 12, 2015 Place of Death: At his residence in Lebanon, Indiana Kent "Zeke" Glendenning was born in Lebanon, Indiana, on April 4, 1935, the son of the late Zara Eugene and Mary Garnet (Lewellen) Glendenning. A life-resident of Perry Township in Boone County, Zeke was a 1953 graduate of Perry Central High School where the students and athletes were known as the "Midgets." Following high school, he served in the U.S. Army for two years and an additional two years in the Army Reserves. He was married to Roberta Ann (Dickey) Glendenning on April 1, 1955, in Speedway, Indiana. Mrs. Glendenning survives. Zeke enjoyed his family and watching his grandchildren as they participated in various sports and activities, especially Morgan's swimming competitions. He was a long-time baseball coach in the Babe Ruth Baseball League in Lebanon for a number of teams including the All-Star Teams. In Lebanon he was employed for several years at GPF Manufacturing before Zeke and his brother, Allen, operated a Brownsburg Window and Siding Company. In 1965 he acquired the Whitestown Tavern and owned it over fifty years. In the early 1950's in Lebanon he purchased the Club 39 which today is known as "Zeke's Club 39" where he remained active until recently. Besides his work, he enjoyed socializing with friends and patrons at "Zeke's club 39."
