Kevin David Milus, 54, of Whitestown and formerly of Raleigh, North Carolina, passed away Monday, September 28, 2015 at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was born on December 10, 1960 in Bellefonte, Pennsylvania, a son of Joan O'Neill Milus and the late Leo J. Milus, Sr.

Kevin was a graduate of Maine-Endwell High School in Endwell, New York. He received his undergraduate degree from Cortland College and his Master's degree from Penn State University.

Following graduate school, Kevin resided in Boca Raton, Florida prior to moving to Raleigh, North Carolina with his family. There, he was a member of St. Francis of Assisi. He worked in Economic Development and Community Planning before starting his own business, Milus Historical Research, where he appreciated researching genealogy.

He was a loving and devoted son, brother and uncle. He had a passion for civil war and was the president of the Raleigh Civil War Round Table. He also enjoyed discussing all things hockey, baseball, and Penn State sports.
