



Larry Lynn Sallee

March 6, 1939 - April 1, 2018

Born March 6, 1939 to Loren "Pat" Sallee and Eunice "Eileen" (Cory) Sallee in Lebanon, the oldest of two sons and died April 1, 2018 at Witham Memorial Hospital after a heroic battle with Lung Cancer. He is preceded in death by his parents.

Larry was a devoted father, husband, brother, and son. He leaves behind his wife of 53 years, Shirley J (Hobart); three sons; Jeff (Candace) Sallee (Alexandra, KY), Scott (Lana) Sallee (Lebanon, In) and Donald L.(Ashley) Sallee (Englewood, Oh); a total of nine grandchildren; and his brother, Donald W.(Eris) Sallee (Avon Park, Florida).

Larry served his country for 21 years in the US Army and after retiring as a Sergeant First Class, he continued to serve his fellow veterans as a Veteran Representative for the Department of Workforce Development for 20 years. He was a fiercely patriotic man, loving his country and fellow veterans, willing to defend and help out when and where he could.

The true love of his life was his wife of 53 years. His love for her could be seen in his eyes when he would talk about her. It was a love that is written about in story books, but lived every day for the two lovebirds. They traveled the world thanks to the US Army, but came back to Lebanon to raise their three sons.

His wishes were to keep arrangements simple and as such there will be a private family gathering at the grave site, complete with a 21 gun salute.
