



Lawrence E. Brandenburg

December 6, 1924 - June 4, 2015

Lawrence E. Brandenburg, age 90, of Lebanon, passed away Thursday June 4th at Homewood Health Campus. Born Dec.6, 1924 in Boone County to the late Harry and Muriel Brandenburg.

Lawrence was a 1943 graduate of Kirklint High School and served as a WWII Navy gunner's mate aboard the U.S.S. Pickaway in the Pacific Theatre.

He was married to Judith A. Caplinger on April 20, 1951, in Lebanon. They lived in W. Lafayette until Lawrence completed his bachelor's degree in Agriculture from Purdue University in 1952. After his graduation the couple made their home in Lebanon for five years before moving to Muncie where Lawrence worked as a livestock buyer for Marhoefer Packing Company. They lived in Muncie until 1977 when the couple moved to their home in Pittsboro.

Lawrence was an avid horse enthusiast and loved to share his hobby with family and friends. He also loved watching sports and backing his beloved boilermakers.

Lawrence was preceded in death by his wife Judith A. Brandenburg and a brother, Orville R. Brandenburg. He is survived by his two children Kathryn Segal and husband David of Westerville, OH and Dr. Terry Brandenburg and fiancé Sue Ashmore of Lebanon. He is also survived by four grandchildren,
