Riley Lee Wilson, 81, of Kirklin, Indiana, passed away on Monday, January 8, 2018, at Franciscan Hospital in Lafayette. He was born in Goshen, Indiana on January 21, 1936, a son of the late Robert Leroy Wilson and Vira M. (Donat) Wilson.

On November 9, 1957, he was married to Suzanne Marie (Kiste) Wilson in Indianapolis. She preceded him in death on April 14, 2003.
