Master Sgt. Daniel Webster Leo Wines, 85, passed away Sunday, January 28, 2018, at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, Indiana. The second son of the late Loral and Rosie L. (Cory) Wines, he was born in Lebanon on November 12, 1932.

Leo had attended Lebanon Schools.

On August 19, 1962, he was married to Tina (Hoogeveen) Wines in Lebanon; she survives.

He began working for Eagle Creek Nursery and was then drafted into the U.S. Army for three years. While in the Army he enlisted in the U.S. Marines for four years. After the U.S. Marines, Leo worked for Stewart – Warner and enlisted in the National Guard for three years. He then worked for EZ Rake and enlisted in the Air Force Reserves, serving 28 years.

Leo's love for serving our country was proven with numerous years in the military. He was stationed in Korea, Alaska, Okinawa, Philippines, Italy, England, Germany, Scotland and Turkey. He retired after 34 ½ years in the service with rank, Master Sergeant.
