Lois Irene Buntin, 94, passed away Monday, August 8, 2022, at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born on September 9, 1927 in Washington Township, Boone County, daughter of the late Gladys (Bever) Bramblett Dale and Edward L. Bramblett.

After graduation from Lebanon High School in 1945, she worked for the law firm of Parr, Parr & Parr. She graduated from Indiana Central Business College.
