Lola Ann Gamble, 82, passed away Monday, August 3, 2020, at Hoosier Village in Zionsville, Indiana. She was born in Champaign, Illinois on January 29, 1938; a daughter of the late Harold "Harry" and Gladys (Parsons) McElwee.

A longtime resident of Whitestown, Lola was a 1956 graduate of Whitestown High School.

On July 12, 1956, she was married to James "Jim" Gamble in Whitestown, Indiana; he survives, and they shared 64 loving years together.

She worked at Fort Harrison and also was a Clerk Treasurer of Whitestown.

Lola was a loving wife and devoted mother.
