Lucinda R. "Cindy" Summers, 76, passed away Sunday, September 26, 2021 at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born on February 17, 1945 in Sioux City, Iowa; a daughter of Stephen F. and Virginia E. (Youngberg) Rosner.
